## Conferences LREC and EAMT 2012 on multilingualism

The PROMISLingua partner LINGUATEC GmbH, a Germany's leading supplier of language technology applications for the office, attended two important events. On May 21-25 Linguatec participated to the eighth international conference on Language Resources and Evaluation, LREC, in Istanbul. LREC has become the major event on Language Resources (LRs) and Evaluation for Human Language Technologies (HLT). Mr. Reinhard Busch and Mrs. Vera Aleksic attended the event. The aim of LREC is to provide an overview of the state-of-

the-art, explore new R&D directions and emerging trends, exchange information regarding LR and their applications, evaluation methodologies and tools, ongoing and planned activities, industrial uses and needs, requirements coming from the e-society, both with respect to policy issues and to technological and organisational ones. LINGUATEC had a booth in the EU Project Village. The presentation included: poster presentation, PROMISLingua self-running demo, presentation of the multilingual approach in the project; interaction with other

conference participants and visitors.

LINGUATEC was also active at the 16th Annual Conference of the European Association for Machine Translation, EMAT 2012, which took place in Trento, Italy on May 28-30. Mr. Gregor Thurmair attended the event. During the conference LINGUATEC promoted the PROMISLingua project, by distributing promotional material, i.e. project posters and flyers.

## Greater Region Business Days in Luxembourg

The second edition of the "Greater Region Business Days" was organised by the Luxembourg Chamber of Commerce on 12-13 June 2012 in the premises of Luxexpo, with the aim to offer participating companies a series of high value B2B services in an interregional and international business atmosphere. PROMIS@Service had a booth and Christian Crelo presented PROMISLingua and the first results achieved during the project.

The second day of the event featured an online live broadcast titled: "How to exploit the cloud revolution to make your company more profitable?"
